

**The Burghill Parish Council Commons
Schedule of those who have Commoners' Rights of Access and Grazing**

The Bird Pool

Burghill PC	Absolute rights as landowner, but the PC does not own the entire pool only the front half approx fronting the highway junction.
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Whitmoorpool Common

There are not any private grazing rights on this common as they were bought out by the BPC in 1975.	
Court farm, Wormsley, Tillington	Right of way over common from road to OS 437 & 438.
Whitmore House, Burghill, Tillington	Right of access over the common to Whitmore House. There's a map somewhere which shows this access – probably the driveway or access to the shed?

Tillington Common

Specific Access Rights	
Montrose	Right of access to the highway – no grazing rights.
Elm Cottage	Right of access – for grazing rights see below.
Grazing Rights	
Heath Farm, Tillington.	15 head of cattle.
Rose Farm, Tillington.	20 sheep or equivalent & to cut gorse.
Linksway, Tillington.	1 pony or equivalent; 25 chickens.
Cherry Trees, Tillington	1 horse.
Roseway, Tillington.	12 hens; 6 ducks; 1 pony.
The Red House, Tillington Re: Mrs B M Wakefield (Bromyard).	15 Cattle or equivalent.
Raven Lodge, Tillington.	1 pony or equivalent.
Elm Cottage, Tillington.	1 pony or equivalent.
Bumble Bee Bower, Tillington.	4 sheep; 50 pullets; 12 cockerels; 12 Turkeys; 4 geese.
Greenlea, Tillington.	6 sheep; 12 chickens.
Herons Croft, Tillington.	1 pony or equivalent, 25 chickens.
	Equivalent grazing ratios: 8 sheep = 1 beast; 10 sheep = 1 horse; 6 sheep = 1 pony; 4 sheep = 1 donkey; 1 sheep = 1 goat.
<i>Note: It is understood that those properties above with grazing rights for commoners would also have rights of access onto the Tillington Common land to tend their livestock.</i>
